2. Data collection

2.1. Minimization

We take care to collect only the relevant, relevant and strictly necessary data for the accomplishment of the purposes for which these data are processed.

2.2. Data

In the context of the navigation on the Website and its use, data correspond to cookies (see 2.3 Cookies policy), and where appropriate, to e-mail addresses and other information that you freely communicate to our firm via the form "Newsletter subscription" and the use of an electronic mailbox in the sections "Contact Us", "Join Us" of the Website.

No personal data is collected without your knowledge.

2.3. Cookies policy

Cookies are small text files generated by the server of the Website that you consult, and deposited by your Internet browser on your device (computer, tablet, mobile phone).

The content of a cookie usually consists of the server name, an expiration date, and a unique encrypted code.

The Website uses Third-Party Cookies:

- Visit statistics cookies that analyse the Site's traffic and measure its audience (Google Analytics);
- Social networking cookies for the sharing of Website content on these media (LinkedIn, Twitter);
- **Emailing tool cookies** that enable us to manage subscriptions to our newsletter, to send the Website's publications and to track their performance (MailChimp).

3. Purpose and legal basis of the processing

4. Data recipients

5. Transfer of data outside Monaco

Data may be transferred to third countries to Monaco on the basis of your consent to the processing.

6. Data retention period

Your personal data is held for the duration necessary for operations for which you have consented to their processing, in accordance with the legislation in force.

7. Rights of the data subject and conditions of exercise

You have a right of access, rectification, opposition to the treatment, and if necessary a right to the portability, the limitation and the erasure of your data, which you can exercise electronically, by post, or directly, to the firm's data controller.

You can withdraw your consent at any time when it constitutes the legal basis of the processing.

The withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing that took place prior to this withdrawal.

8. Right of recourse

If necessary, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the Commission de contrôle des informations nominatives (CCIN) in accordance with Law No. 1.165 of 23 December 1993 consolidated, and, if applicable, with the relevant authority in charge of the protection of personal data in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of 27 April 2016 (GDPR).
